Progress Reports and Student Led Conferences

On Friday, November 14th, students will receive an Initial Observation of Learning (JK and SK) or a Progress Report (Grade 1-8). These documents are a look into how your child's school year has started in the academic areas and learning skills. These reports are often indicators of where students might need some support as they move through their year. In the afternoon and evening of November 20th as well as the morning of November 21st, teachers will be available to participate in Student Led conferences, where students are highly encouraged to attend to discuss what the reports have indicated. Appointments will be scheduled for 20 minutes in length and will have other families in the room at the same time.
